

An Introduction to Neglect – Level 1

Aim

To enable practitioners to recognise and respond to the signs and symptoms of child neglect and ensure that the needs of children and young people are assessed in order to prevent long term consequences on their health and welfare.

Learning Outcomes

At the end of the session delegates will have had an opportunity to:

- Be able to recognise and respond to the signs and symptoms of child neglect
- Understand the long-term consequences of neglect on children and young people
- Understand why parents are not always able to meet the basic needs of their children
- Be able to assess the needs of neglected children and analyse risk
- Enable practitioners to recognise the constraints within their practice that prevents them from responding appropriately to the needs of neglected children.

Neglect – Level 2

Aim:

To enable practitioners responsible for assessing the needs of children and young people who are suffering neglect to recognize the impact of neglect and through good assessment, reduce the impact of any significant harm suffered.

Learning outcomes:

By the end of the training, practitioners, through case discussion and studies will:

- Have knowledge of the latest research on neglect
- Understand the long term consequences of neglect on the child’s health and well being
- Be aware of the impact of poor attachment and bonding
- Explore the tools available for assessing the impact of neglect on the child or young person

The training is for practitioners who are responsible for assessing the needs of children and families i.e. social workers, health visitors, school nurses.

Aim

Understand the evidence based research behind the development of and use of the Quality of care toolkit, Introduce the Quality of care toolkit tool kit, Develop the skills to use the tool kit, Understand the analysis process in a child focussed way. Consider how a Quality of care toolkit assessment is used in future service and support development for the children and their families

Learning Outcomes:

By the end of the training session:

- There will be a better understanding of the complexities of working to address child and adolescent neglect and the need for structured judgement tools
- There will be a better understanding of the Quality of care toolkit and how to use it
- Have an understanding how to adapt the way Quality of care toolkit is used in regards to the family's needs/ability to participate and recognition and respect for their cultural context
- Have an better understanding of how to complete the tool kit using multi-agency input
- The candidate would have completed a Quality of care toolkit, the analysis and compiled a future child focussed action plan to work with the family to reduce the risks/concerns
- The candidate will have a better understanding of when to step up their concerns using the Quality of care toolkit as additional evidence.

Aims & Learning Outcomes

This free training session introduces the Outcome Star - a tool designed to help families, children, young people and adults see where they may need to make changes in their lives and then help them to make those changes. The Stars provide a strong visual representation of strengths and areas where families or individuals need support and illustrate where progress is being made and any areas that remain stuck. An understanding of how the Outcome Star can assist with the completion of a holistic needs assessment e.g. CAF

Learning Outcomes

- By the end of this session participants will be able to:
- Introduce the appropriate star to children, young people and families
- Complete outcome stars with service users
- Illustrate to clients where progress is being made and areas that remain stuck Utilise a robust evaluation tool for identifying distance travelled
- Use the data collected from the stars to support evaluation of service
- Understanding of how the Outcome Star can assist with the completion of a holistic assessment e.g. CAF
